The land at Wheatley Campus is a previously developed site in the Green Belt. It has been proposed for release in previous draft Local Plans but in the end retained.					
CPRE has consistently argued that as a previously developed site it can be redeveloped whilst					
retaining Green Belt status, with allowance made for the benefit of removing the tower block which					
dominates the site, and it is relevant that SODC officers argued exactly that in supporting a redevelopment application (P17/S4254) for 300 houses (the Plan number) in November 2018.					
Although that application was refused the principle remains that Green Belt release is not necessary					
to develop the built area of the site and as the Local Plan site release intends to retain the unbuilt part					
of the site as green space there is no justification whatsoever for the release proposed.
